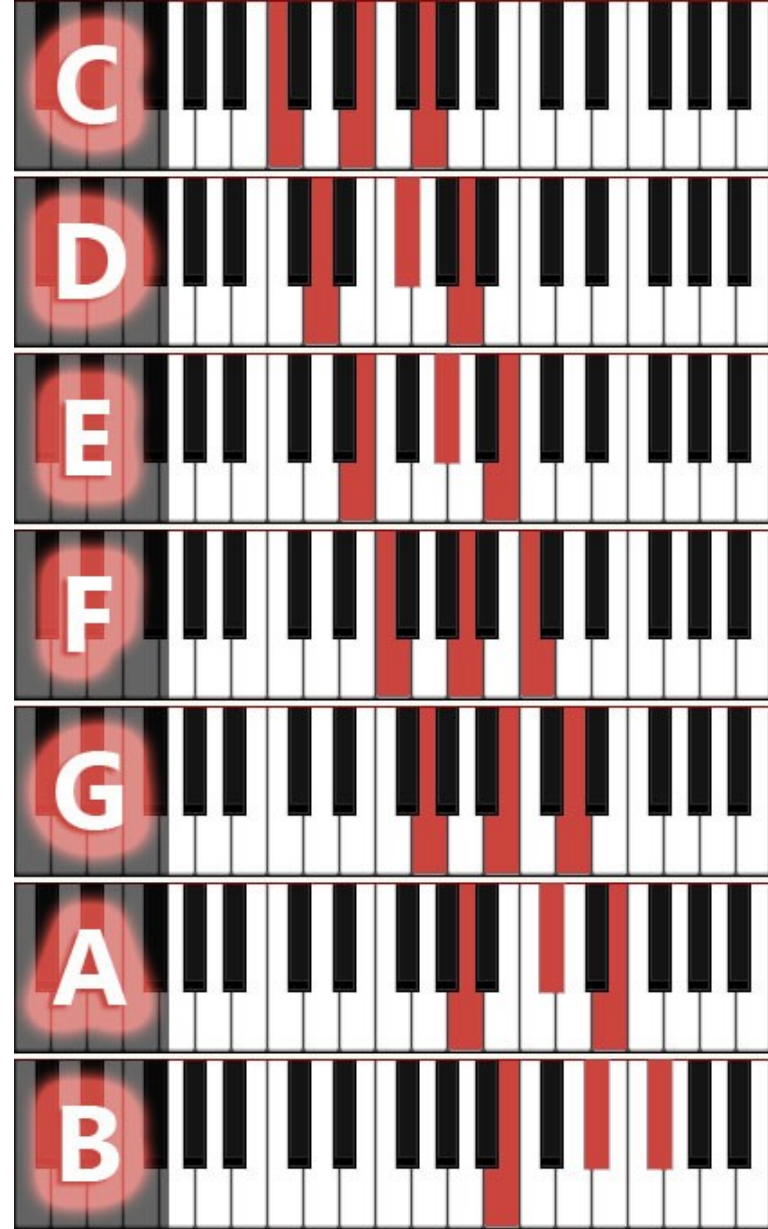

Below you can see an overview of all major chords in the common keys (only naturals, no accidentals).

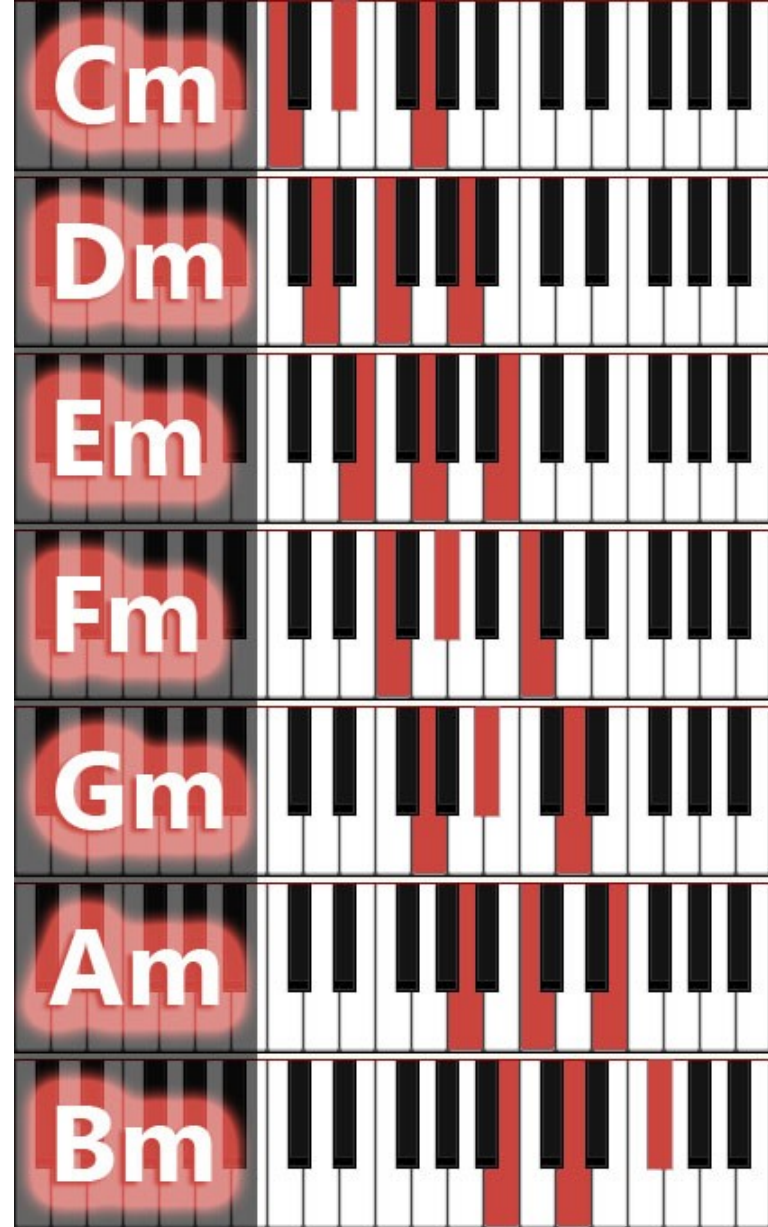
Major piano chords overview

Below you can see an overview of all minor chords in the common keys (only naturals, no accidentals).

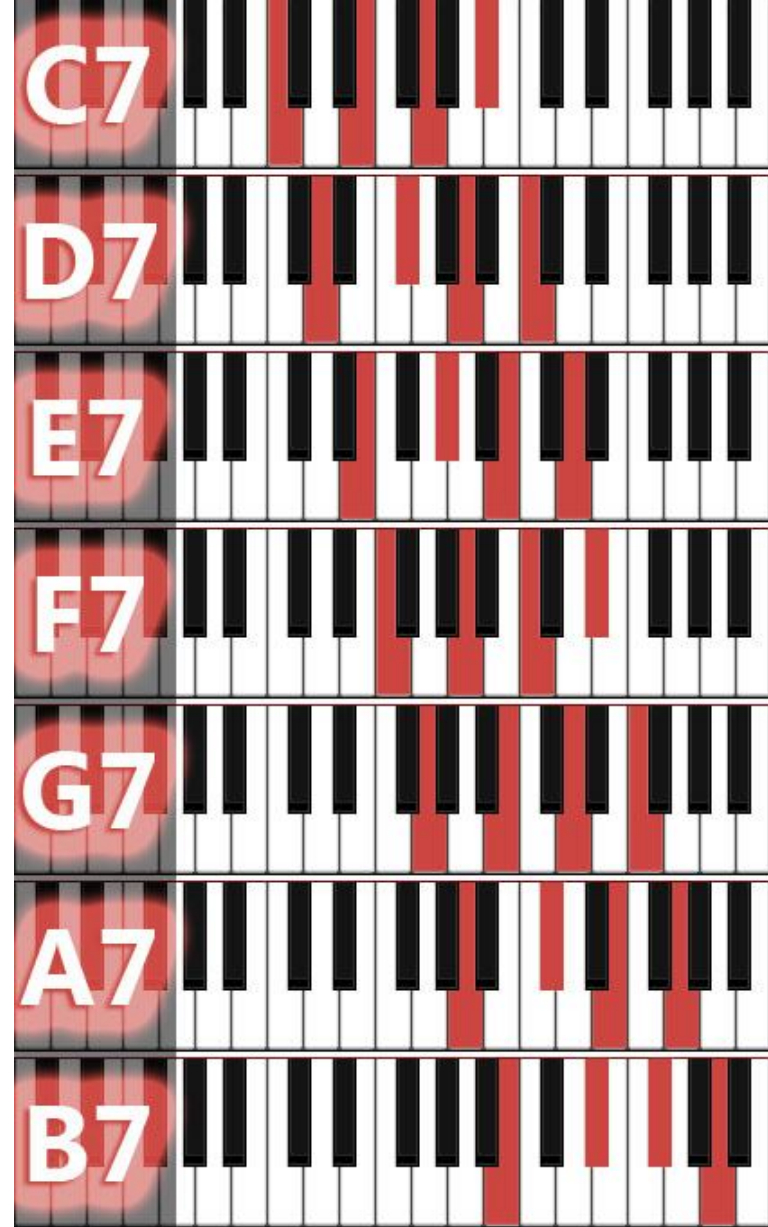
Minor piano chords overview



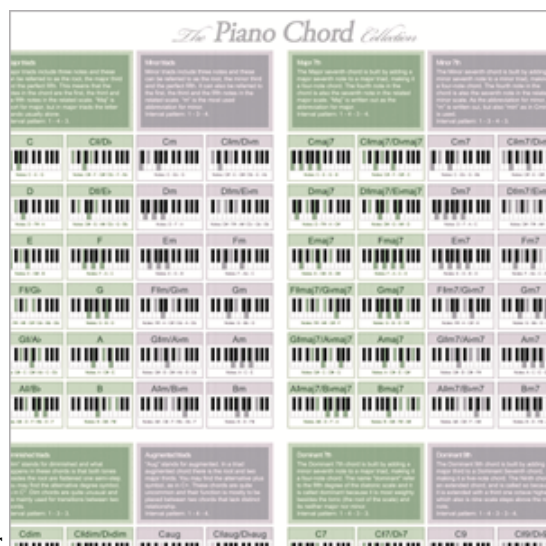
As before, the fingers can play on any octave of the keyboard.
